Lesson 2: How to form it?

Verb + -ing (present participle). See below for examples in each form:

a) Affirmative:

I **am watching** the TV../ I'**m watching** the TV.

He/She/It **is working**. /He's/She's/It's **working**.

We/You/They **are listening** to music./ We'**re/You're/They're listening** to music..

b) Questions

Am I **watching** the TV?

Is he/she/it **working**?

Are you/we/they **listening** to music?

c) Negative

I **am not watching** the TV./I'**m not watching** the TV.

He/She/It **is not working**./He/She/It's **not working**.

We/You/they **are not listening** to music./We'**re not/You're not/They're not listening** to music.
