Lesson 2: How to form it?

Verb + -ing (present participle). See below for examples in each form:

a) Affirmative:

I am watching the TV../ I'm watching the TV.

He/She/It is working. /He's/She's/It's working.

We/You/They are listening to music./ We're/You're/They're listening to music..

b) Questions

Am I watching the TV?

Is he/she/it working?

Are you/we/they listening to music?

c) Negative

I am not watching the TV./I'm not watching the TV.

He/She/It is not working./He/She/It's not working.

We/You/they are not listening to music./We're not/You're not/They're not listening to music.
