1. If we /not hurry up/, we /miss/ the plane.
  - A. If we won't hurry up, we'll miss the plane.
  - B. If we don't hurry up, we'll miss the plane.
  - C. If we won't hurry up, we miss the plane.
  
2. If we /have/ enough time, we /visit/ John.
  - A. If we have enough time, we'll visit John.
  - B. If we have enough time, we'll visit John.
  - C. If we have enough time, we'd visit John.
  
3. If something bad /can happen/, it /happen/.
  - A. If something bad will happen, it can happen.
  - B. If something bad could happen, it will happen.
  - C. If something bad can happen, it will happen.
  
4. /You let/ me know if you /speak/ to her?
  - A. Will you let me know if you spoke to her?
  - B. Do you let me know if you'll speak to her?
  - C. Will you let me know if you speak to her?
  
5. She /be angry/ if you /not invite/ her.
  - A. She will be angry if you don't invite her.
  - B. She is angry if you won't invite her.
  - C. She would be angry if you don't invite her.
  
6. If you /ask/ him nicely, he /lend/ you the car.

  - C. We'll go for a walk if it doesn't rain.
10. The teacher /be/ angry unless you /do/ your homework.
- A. The teacher will be angry unless you do your homework.
  - B. The teacher will be angry unless you don't do your homework.
  - C. The teacher will be angry unless you won't do your homework.
